(4) Cased to 454, Size 2".

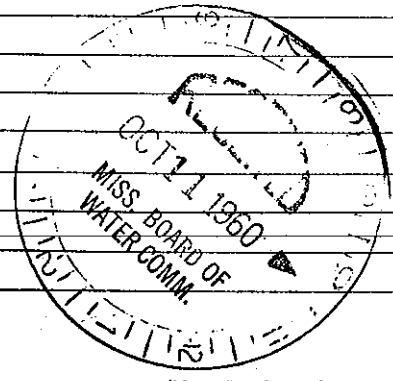
